In honor of the 7<sup>TH</sup> Annual Door County Scottie Rally, we have something new and special for the creative folks who love Scotties & wish to support the mission inspired by Shayna McPunim Bronsky. **Hottie Scottie Bodies** will be available for your creative ideas.

*You are invited to make an application (Phase 1) to finish one Scottie with bone shaped wood base, in a medium that you choose to work with. The completed Scottie will be returned by the registration deadline of the 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Door County Scottie Rally in 2008; and auctioned (Phase 2) at that event, to help raise funds for Scottie health care issues.*

Each of the entries will be photographed and submitted for a color booklet (Phase 3) which will then be offered at the 9<sup>th</sup> Annual Door County Scottie Rally in 2009. The back pages of the booklet will give credit to the artist and to the individuals who have purchased the completed project through the auction phase of the contest.

All proceeds from the auction of the little Scotties and the sale of this book will also be donated to the Door County Scottie Rally for the Scottish Terrier Club of America (STCA) Health Trust Fund. This is your opportunity to be a featured artist in the book "Best of Show", along with the name you have selected for your project.

The idea for this project was inspired by a contest held several years ago by Karen Campbell of Campbell's Scottish Terriers in Virginia, with permission by Karen Campbell. The costs to acquire the Scottie forms and wood bases have been generously donated by two Friends of the Door County Scottie Rally.

For an established donation of \$10, the "featured artist" agrees to complete one Scottie and base for the good of providing support and funding for Scottie health and research issues. This has been the mission of the Door County Scottie Rally; and this project is a way to encourage people to participate actively and creatively to help meet this commitment to our beloved Scottish Terriers.

Please check out the first Hottie Scottie Body created this year by Sue Fronsee. She has graciously agreed to complete this inspiration for the introduction of this contest. Sue's creation this year, will also be included in the 2008 competition and in the 2009 "Best of Show" book.
